3rd Grade Assessment

East Hickman Intermediate School has elected to participate in a field test of the new Grade 2 Assessment. This assessment is designed to replace the SAT-10, the current grade 2 assessment. To prevent pre-exposure, the test will be administered to third-grade students based on content standards they learned in the prior school year. The field test will take place the week of September 19 - 23 where students will be assessed in ELA and Math. The assessment will provide invaluable data to both second and third grade teachers, ensuring that our youngest students are strengthening foundational literacy and math skills early in their academic careers.
