The Hickman County School District has named March 6-10 as Attendance Week. This is a challenge between schools in the district to achieve 100% attendance during March 6-10. Students will be eligible to receive daily, as well as weekly, incentives for perfect attendance!

Attendance is essential to school success.

Chronic absence — missing 10 percent of the school year, or just 2-3 days every month—can translate into third-graders unable to master reading, sixth-graders failing courses, and ninth-graders dropping out of high school. Clearly, attending school regularly matters!

Parents and families are essential partners in promoting good attendance. Just as parents should focus on how their children are performing academically, they have a responsibility to set expectations for good attendance and to monitor their children's absences, so that missed days don't add up to academic trouble.
